

QHSE POLICY STATEMENT (5.3)

"Straininstall are committed to ensuring our future prosperity by working together with its customers, staff, suppliers, regulators and any other stakeholders to meet and satisfy precisely their requirements and each other's, first time, on time and every time. Our products shall be manufactured in a safe, healthy and environmentally friendly manner where this is possible".

The Company recognises the benefits which a customer focussed integrated business management system can offer. To this end, Straininstall seeks to develop our chosen markets and secure our trading position by enhancing the skills of the staff and by fostering an environment for continual improvement and lean manufacturing.

The products that we manufacture, assemble and supply will be safe to use in the environment for which they were purchased. Adherence to customer requirements, ease of installation, long term performance of our products, and continually improve the effectiveness of the quality management system are fundamental business goals achieved through implementation of the following objectives:

- Review and confirmation of all critical product and service requirements with the customer prior to contract acceptance.
- Qualification of system designs through testing at a level exceeding the intended operating parameters of the product.
- Supply chain management through external auditing of critical suppliers to verify capability to meet specified product requirements prior to supply.
- Supply of bespoke installation instructions and product training to customers including the provision of on-site field service engineering.
- Continuous monitoring and prevention of nonconforming internally manufactured and externally supplied components and products.
- Proactive monitoring of process improvement opportunities through continuous management review and internal auditing.


The Company shall provide a safe, healthy and environmentally friendly facilities for its employees to carry out its operations.

- Identifying and reducing, where it is practicable to do so, any significant health and safety hazards and risks; and significant environmental aspects and impacts which arise from its processes and operations.

- The minimisation of waste, use of energy and natural resources.
- Comply as a minimum with relevant, health, safety and environmental legislation and regulations, and with any other requirements to which the organisation subscribes.

The Company shall keep our management system compliant with the requirements of BS EN ISO 9001, BS EN ISO 14001, BS OHSAS 18001 and ISO/IEC 80079-34 (also product compliance with the type described in the EC type-examination certificates/IECEX Certificates of Conformance) and review these systems for suitability to our changing business needs and improve their effectiveness where and when appropriate.

From this policy, we have established a set of measurable objectives that will provide the means for determining business success and achievement of our commitment to quality, ensuring that staff are working at all times in a safe, healthy, working facility that is reducing our environmental impact to a minimum. These objectives will be reviewed on a regular basis by senior managers within the business and the results made available to all staff.
